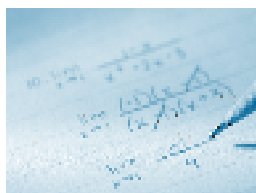

ABOUT THE TOPIC

ABSTRACTS

Authors are invited to submit a maximum 1 000 characters long abstract on A4 format paper. Times New Roman 12pt regular font must be used. Abstracts can be submitted by e-mail, to the address for Correspondence. All abstracts will be reviewed and notification of acceptance will be sent via e-mail by May 15, 2010. All the scientific papers for the journal are peer reviewed by the international Editorial Board. The formatting rules for the papers will be provided later.
